### ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

#### Oak Grove Elementary Site

Add new classrooms, a cafeteria, bus loading zone, and a modernization of the existing building creating a minimum capacity of 400 students. \$ 18,000,000

#### New Elementary School

Construct a new school with a minimum capacity of 500 students in Northeast Albany. \$ 36,000,000

### HIGH SCHOOLS

#### West Albany High School

Construct the first phase of a school replacement which will include classrooms, multi-purpose commons space, vocational-technical education space, and an auditorium. \$ 42,000,000

#### South Albany High School

Auxiliary gymnasium/multipurpose vocational-technical education space	\$ 3,500,000
Existing Little Theatre Renovations	\$ 500,000
Modernization and expansion of vocational-technical education spaces	\$ 6,000,000

### MIDDLE SCHOOL VOCATIONAL-TECHNICAL

Middle School Vocational-Technical Education Space Remodeling	\$ 3,000,000
