The district uses the percentage of the day worked in determining whole day and half day pay. For example, if you accept a sub position that starts mid-morning and you work for 4.0 hours then you will only be paid for a half-day even though you have worked into the afternoon. If a half-day morning assignment is longer than 4.0 hours then the certified substitute will be paid for a full day. In the event you are called to a building for which you are not needed, you will be reimbursed for one-half day. The school then retains the right to have you assist in the office or in a classroom if appropriate.
