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## Passenger Permission Form

Various times during the year, students may have a need to ride in a private car due to sports practices, internships, co-op work experience, cadet teaching, business partnerships and conducting assigned business for school newspaper, leadership, annual, rally, dance team, etc. I believe the events for which my student will travel in a privately owned vehicle are educationally valuable.
