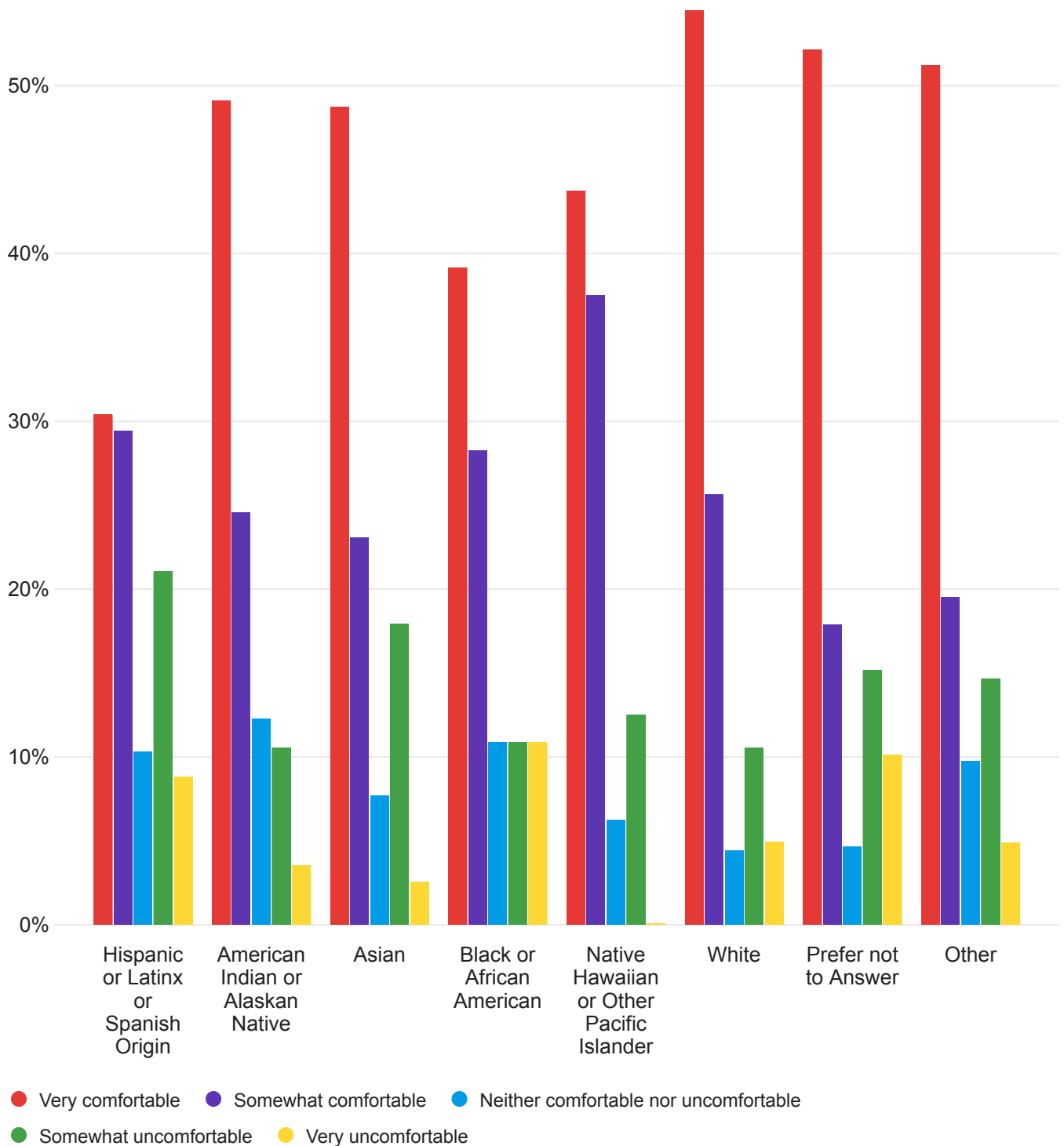


GAPS Family Survey Results by Race/Ethnicity

If public health officials believe it is safe to allow in-person instruction (using OHA/ODE guidance), how comfortable would you be in having your student(s) physically return to school this fall?

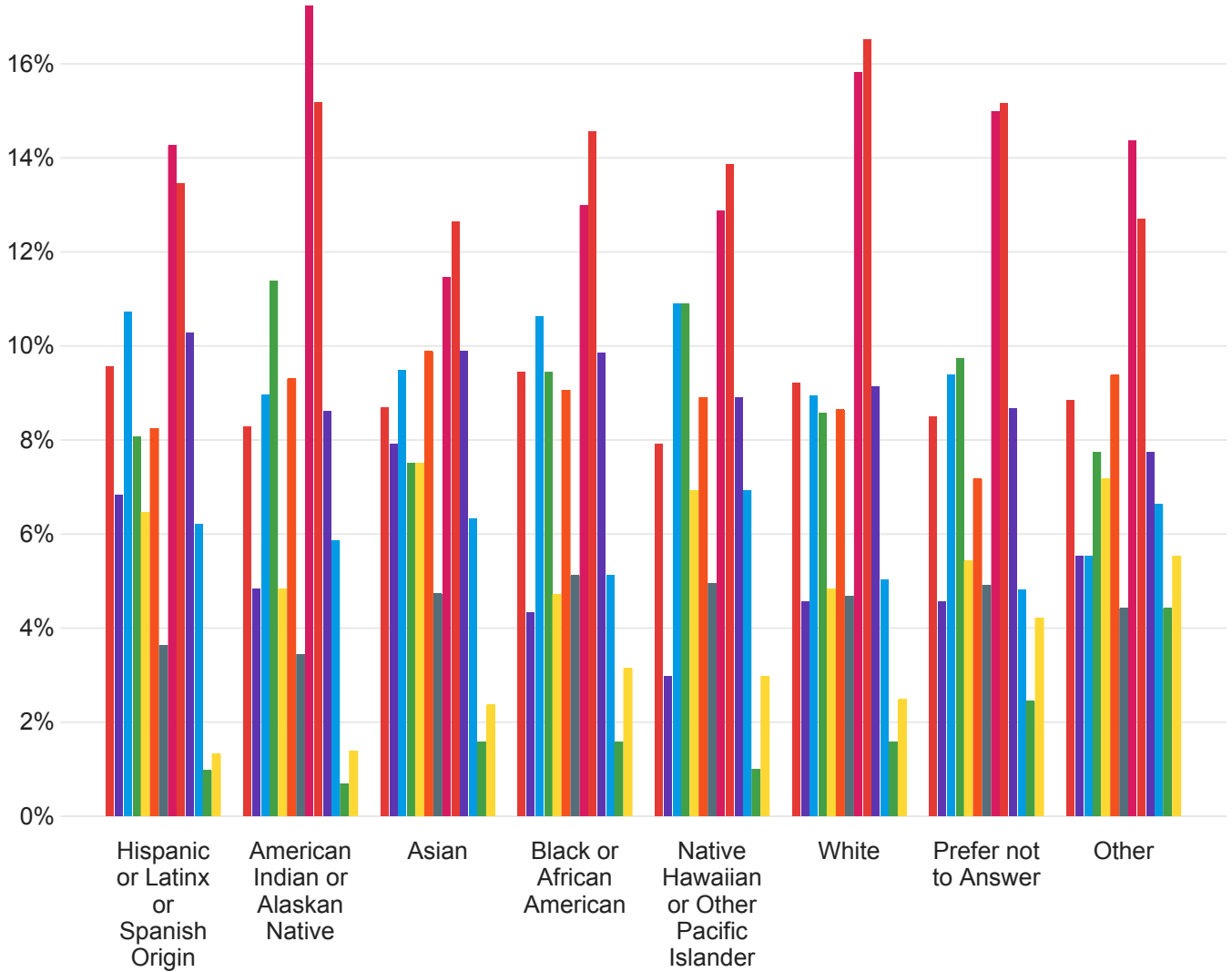

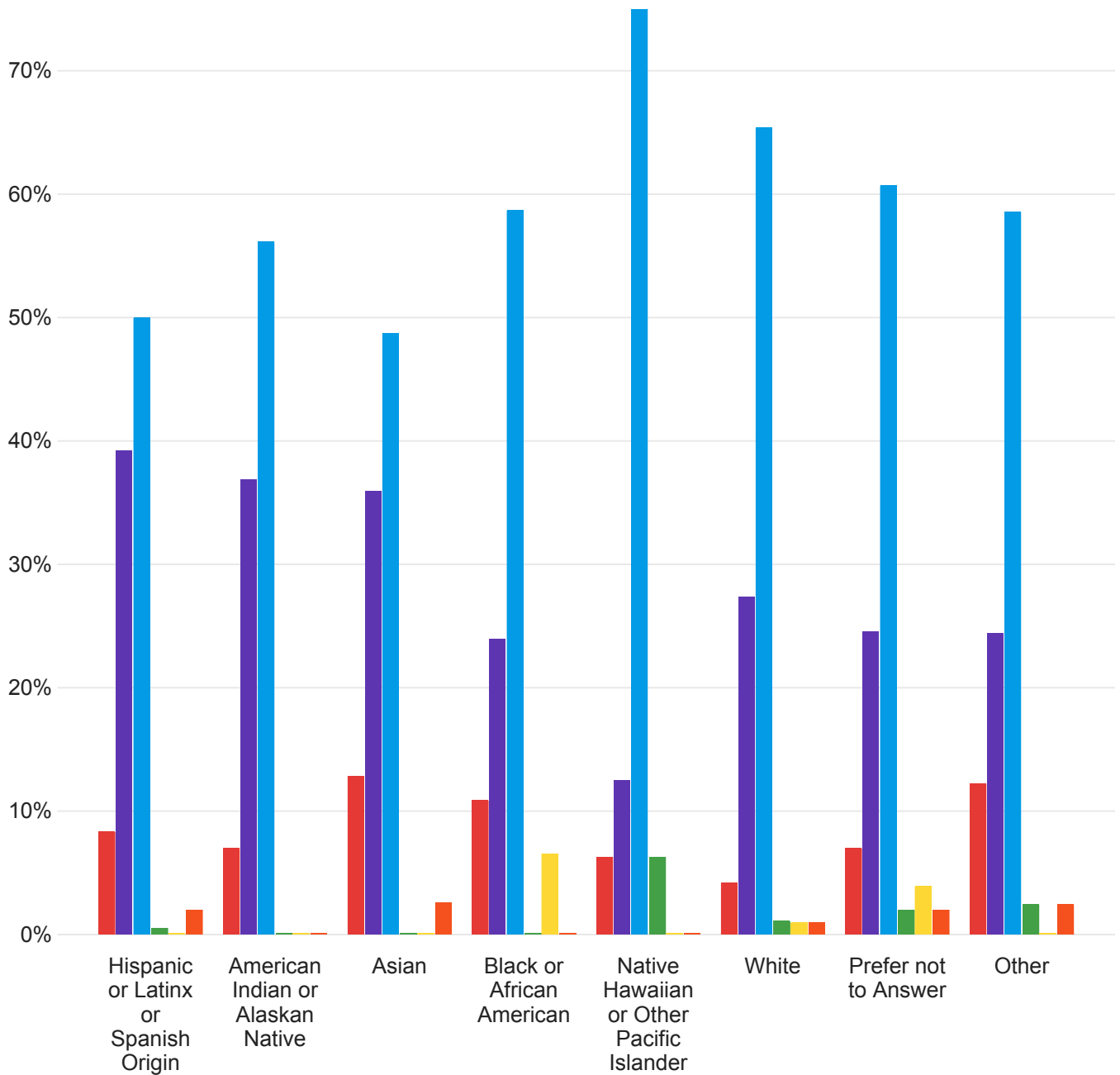


- Class sizes are small enough to allow social distancing

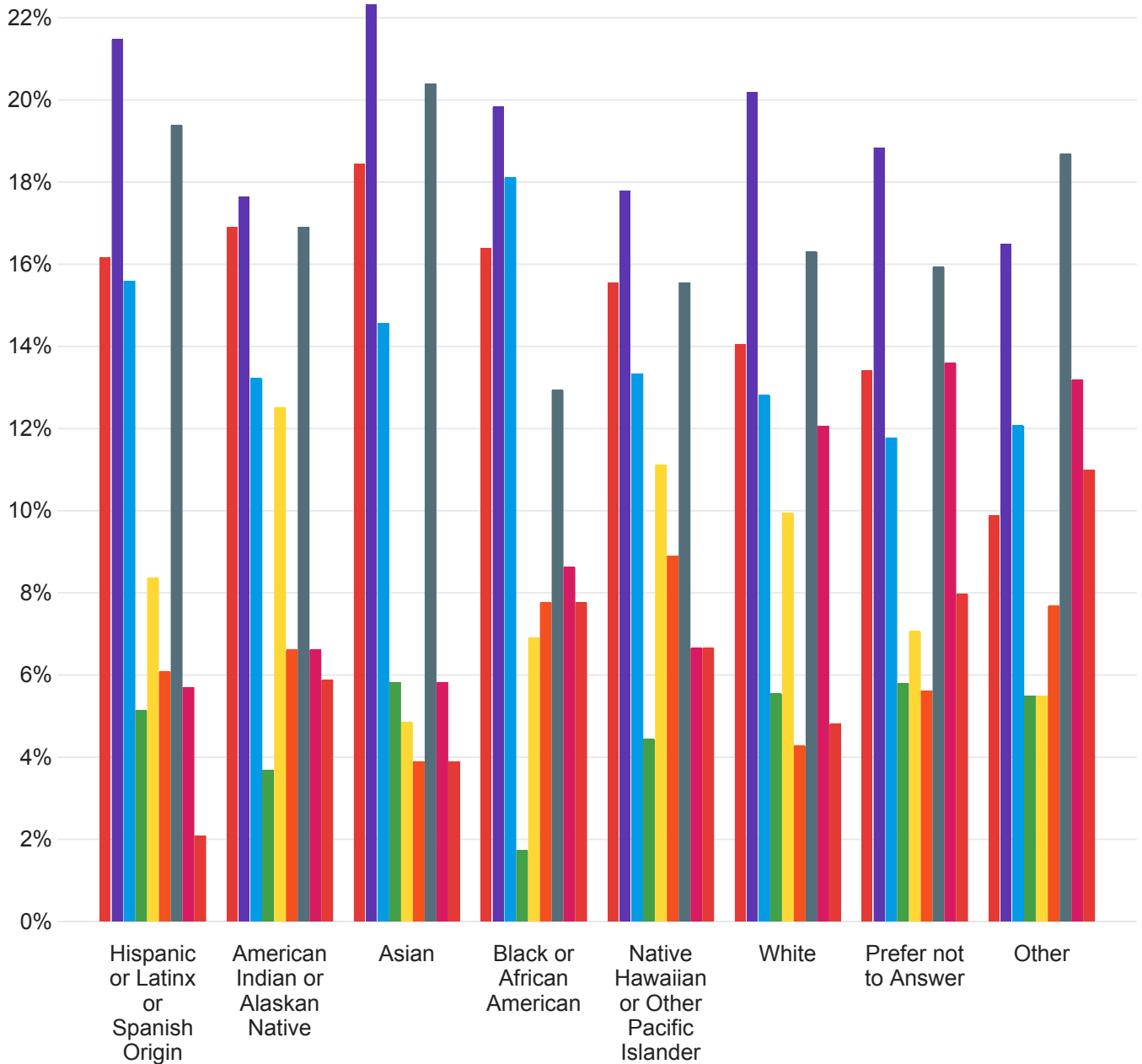

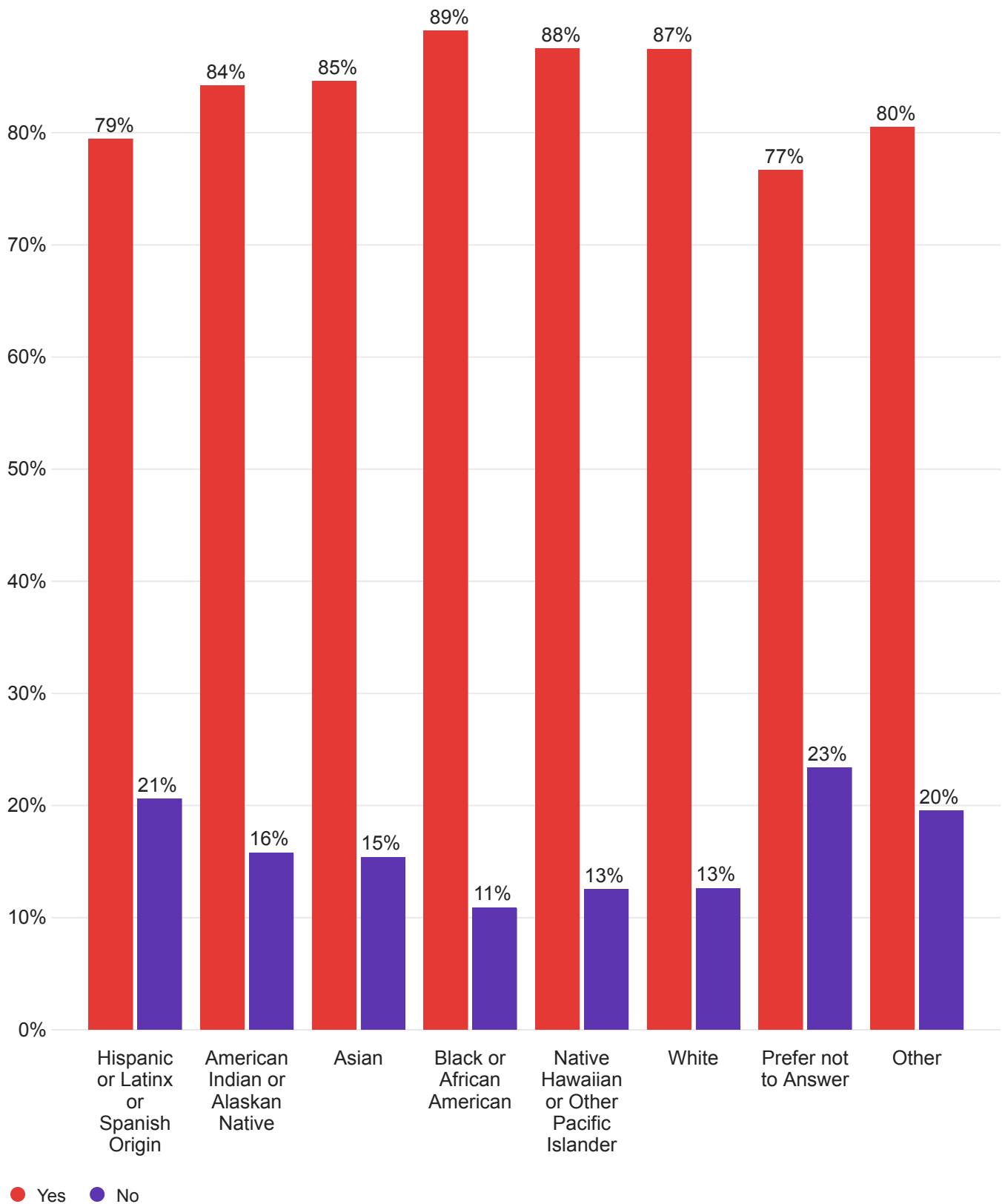


- Public health regulations not being followed
