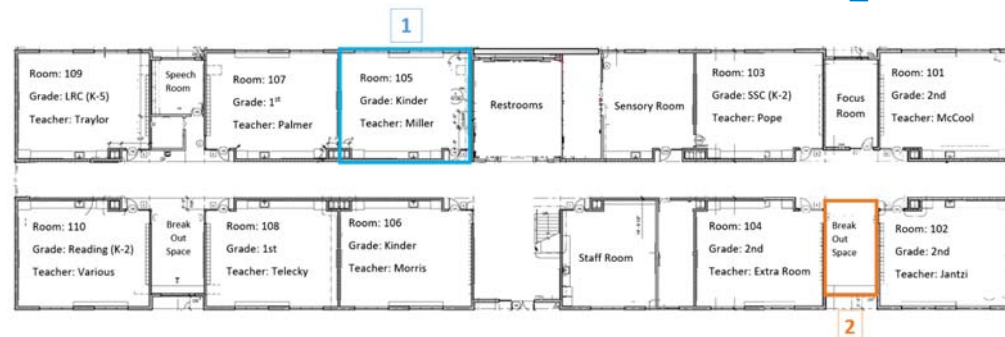
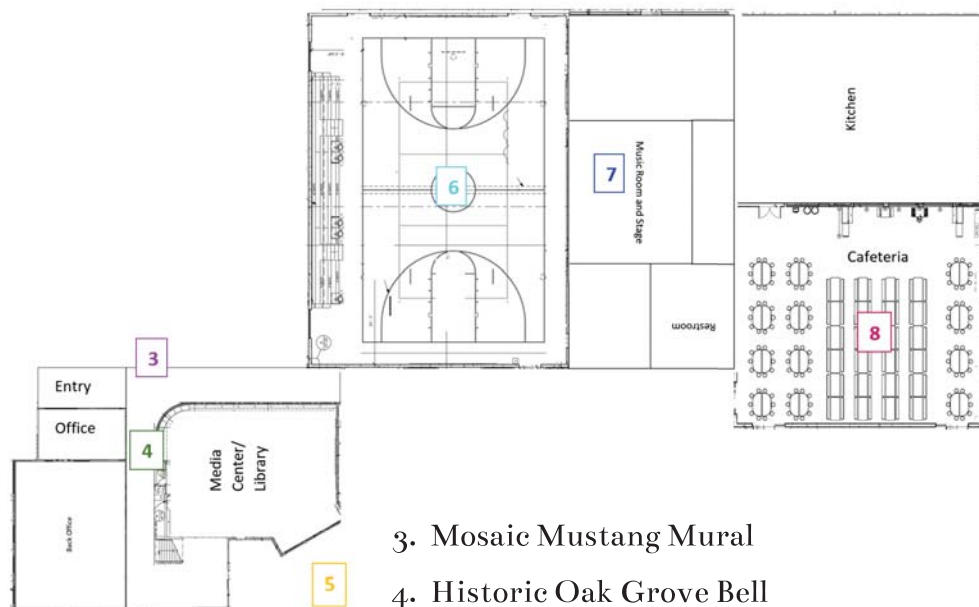


First Floor Classroom Map



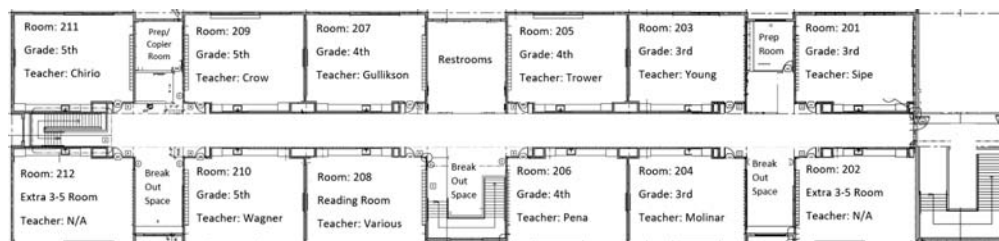
1. Sample Classroom you can enter and look around.

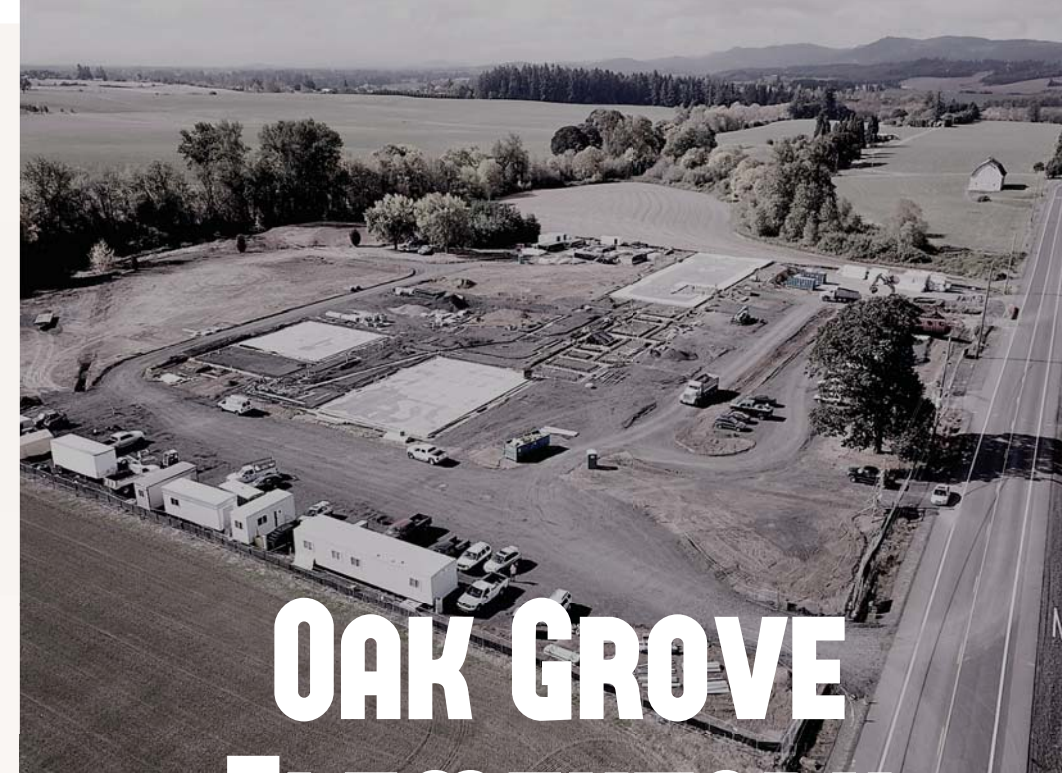

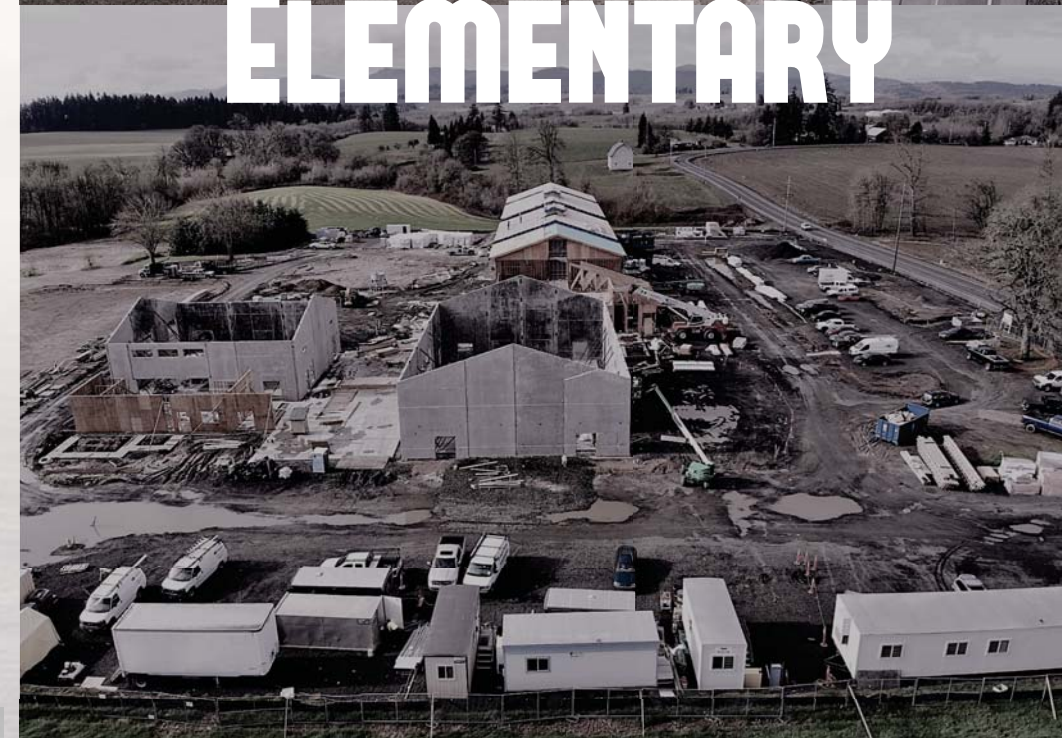

Alternative Learning Spaces

Try to locate the following spaces:

- ▶ Student and Adult Learning Space in the Media Center
- ▶ Teacher Professional Learning Community (PLC) Space (hint: look on the second floor).
- ▶ Outdoor Mini Amphitheater (hint: look out the Media Center windows)
- ▶ Break Out Small Group Spaces:

Walk into the Gymnasium to see several spaces including: Physical Education, Large Group Presentation, Music Education, and our Performance Stage complete with lights, amplification, and recording capabilities.

- ▶ Cafeteria which has many community style round tables to encourage socialization and has our third and final large group presentation and learning space.

Technology to Transform Learning

- ▶ Interactive Televisions connect the teacher's computer to the touch screen display on which students can manipulate information.
- ▶ Voice Lift Amplifiers allow teachers to speak at their normal volume and students in all areas of class can hear them through ceiling speakers. It also has the capabilities to connect directly to cochlear implants for hearing impaired students.
- ▶ Color Change Lighting in the Special Programs Classroom assists student in emotional and physical regulation and helps with focus and productivity.
- ▶ Document Cameras allow students to share their work and get feedback from their whole class at once.

Preserving Pieces of the Past



- ▶ Look for the original historic bell in the display case outside the Media Center. Below you can see the bell atop the 1887 Oak Grove One-Room School House.
- ▶ Look for the Mosaic Mustang Mural created in 2010 by Oak Grove students as you enter the main hall. Each child was able to paint a wood square that came together to create our very own mustang.

Energy Efficiencies for Sustainable Schools

Below are just a few features integral to supporting Oak Grove's energy efficient operations:

- ▶ Our WaveLinX Wireless Connected Lighting Systems are cost-effective and energy saving. They reduced our construction costs and are capable of configuring each area to meet specific lighting needs.
- ▶ Oak Grove was outfitted with KMC building automation system controls which monitor each space's temperature and occupancy rather than vacancy. If a space is vacant that HVAC system will go into an energy saver mode which is much more effective than the alternative approach.
- ▶ Another great feature are our Lochinvar FTXL boilers with 98% efficiency, and a 10:1 firing modulation.

- ▶ We also installed Multistack Variable Speed Chiller Modules which provide significant efficiency gains over chillers with fixed speed compressors. These chillers can qualify for USGBC LEED points and utility rebates. As a bonus, Multistack is the first HVAC manufacturer to offer AHRI-certified modular chillers!
