- Corvallis has increased its monthly cap to \$1,475 and added an additional \$50 to its pooling, resulting in a **\$1,525** per month cap.
- Lebanon has increased its licensed monthly cap to \$1,515.
- GAPS has offered a \$50 increase to its cap, bringing the monthly insurance cap
 to \$1,648 for 2024-25. The final pooling calculation will also increase. Final
